**Michael Witkes** (Pink Pancake, Writer, Producer) is an NYC-based multi-hyphenate; actor, writer, director, producer and Drag Queen (@hausofpancake). He is most known for his work creating, producing, and starring in the award-winning series, *INTERESTED IN*. Seasons 1 and 2 were official selections at 12 film festivals, including Frameline. Season 2 was a recipient of a 2022 NYC Women's Fund Grant (Dir. Erica Rose) and was nominated for a Queerties Award. The series has over 23 million views and 55K subscribers on YouTube. It's been featured in HuffPost, Queerty, NewNowNext, and Gayety, among others. Michael's short film, *BOYS WILL*, was a semifinalist in Diverse Voices, WeScreenplay, and Big Apple Film Festivals. As a Drag Queen, Michael performs all over the city as "Pink Pancake;" most notably with Susanne Bartsch. Pancake has won numerous drag competitions in NYC and was featured in Condé Nast Traveler's "WHAT WE PACK SERIES." Stuart's been actively creating Queer Jewish experiences since 2017, starting with THE SHABBOS QUEENT, A QUEER & DREAMY SHABBAT DINNER DELIGHT & EXTRAVAGANZA, which continues to tour internationally. Other performance works include THE DYBBUK PART 2, KOPFKINO (head cinema), WITCH DANCE, THE YENTA SHOW, PRIDE INSIIIDE and NEVER CAN SAY GOODBYE. As a performer, Stuart has worked alongside Tino Sehgal, Robert Wilson, Nick Cave, A.R.M., Ann Liv Young, Christopher Williams, Thomas Bo Nilsson & Mina Nishimura. Stuart received funding from the Berlin Cultural Senate, the BK Arts Council, the Harkness Foundation and the NEA, and was a NYLA Fresh Tracks Artist, a Triskelion Arts + CPR AIR, and a danceWeb Scholar @ Impulstanz in Vienna. Stuart organizes Brooklyn's queer Jewish dance party FLAMINGGG (@flamingggnyc) and has also created happenings for FED, B'nai Jacob, JQY, and Lab/Shul. They're also a Hypnotist (IHF), read Tarot + Dreams through a Kabbalistic tradition and DJ regularly as "Party Girl." @stuartbmeyers

Creative producing includes *THE MOSS MAIDENS* (Shenyc, Best Play), COMMUNION (the cell), CAREGIVER CABARET (PAAL, ART/NY), RUTH SENT US, CHANGEMAKERS, and STRONGER THAN HATE (The Green Room 42). Favorite roles include ON THE TOWN (Hildy), GUYS AND DOLLS (Adelaide), ALL SHOOK UP (Miss Sandra), RENT (Maureen), and LOVE'S LABOUR'S LOST (Maria). International Tours include DISNEY ON CLASSIC (Mother Gothel) and JESUS CHRIST SUPERSTAR. Mara made her Carnegie Hall debut in WE ARE HERE: SONGS FROM THE HOLOCAUST.
